OPEN MODELING will begin promptly after the completion of all group events.

PAGEANT MODELING: Contestants will model in the circle "T" pattern with seated interview at the end of the modeling performance.

***JUDGING will be based on 40% twirl, 40% strut, and 20% modeling/interview.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Doors open Saturday, April 8, 2017, 7:30 a.m. Contest begins at 8:30 a.m.
 2. Jazz shoes, twirling shoes or tennis shoes permitted on gym floor for performance events.
 3. Concessions will be available. No food, drinks, or smoking in the gym or dressing rooms.
- NO EXCEPTIONS.**
4. Wetumpka High School and/or NBTA contest directors will not be responsible for participant or spectators' injury traveling to/from/while at event, nor will it be held responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property belonging to individuals.
 5. No lawn chairs or any other type of furniture permitted in/on gym floor. No blankets on floor.
 6. Music for groups will be kept at sound level that is comfortable for the listening pleasure of the audience (85 decibel limit).
 7. Rules and procedures in this brochure and the mechanics at this contest are and will be enforced in accordance with NBTA standards, NBTA rules, score sheets, and approved judges will be employed.
 8. Contest age rule: A contestant's age for the following contest year will be in every case determined by actual age on preceding Sept. 1.
 9. Novice event winners will be awarded ribbons only.
 10. Loveliest Majorette: Modeling attire - see item #17. Model in circle "T." No interview.
- Beginner Loveliest division - Novice/Beginner levels only. Advanced division - Intermediate/Advanced levels only.
11. Best Appearing Modeling will be done without a baton; contestants shall be required to wear a twirling costume of their choice and must enter at least one other twirling or strut event at this contest.
 12. A division may not be reopened once it has been closed.
 13. "Open Contest" events are open to all twirlers regardless of residence.
 14. Costumes must be worn for the Miss Majorette Awards pictures (Otherwise they will not be sent to Drum Major Magazine to be published.)
 15. No refunds, sorry.
 16. Novice rule - 30 sec. - 2 min.
 17. Advanced division dress code: 0-6 and 7-9 divisions - short party dress; 10-12 - long or tea length party dress; 13-15, 16 & Over and College - long or tea length dress. Modeling attire for novice, beginner and intermediate divisions (all age groups) is the same twirling or strut costume worn in twirling or strutting portion of pageant.
 18. Basic Skills I (wrist spins right & left, fig. 8 right & left, reverse figure 8 right & left, horizontal spins right & left, 2-hand spins w/body pass, 2-hand spins w/leg pass).
 19. Basic Skills II (all of above, plus right thumb flips, left hand back hand flips, Little Joes (side flips) at each side, vertical split finger right & left, horizontal split finger right & left).
