PARADE CORPS –Jr, Sr, A, Open

SHOW CORPS – Jr, Sr, A, Open (timing 3:00-6:00 min)

TWIRL TEAMS – TinyTot, Primary, Juvenile, Junior, Senior(3:00-4:00 min)

SHOW TEAM – Beginner, Advance, A, Open (timing 2:00-3:00 min)

Artistic TWIRL TEAMS – Beginner, Advance (timing 2:00-3:00 min)

Artistic Twirl Teams blend dance steps or series in combination with the baton, coordinated with music.

TRIO – TinyTot, Primary, Juvenile, Junior, Senior

SHORT PROGRAM

FREESTYLE & FREESTYLE PAIRS (non-competitive critique only)

COMPLUSORIES/MOVEMENT TECHNIQUE – C, B, A, AA, AAA, Elite (may be spread throughout day)

USTA STRUT – Novice*, Beginner, Intermediate, Advance (timing 1:10)

MICHIGAN STATE USTA STRUT – Advance (timing 1:10)

2 BATON – Novice, Beginner, Intermediate, Advance (timing Beg/Int 1:29)

MICHIGAN STATE 2 BATON – Advance (timing 1:44)

3BATON – Novice, Beginner, Intermediate, Advance (timing 1:29 min)

MICHIGAN STATE 3 BATON – Advance (timing 1:29 min)

BASIC STRUT (foundation event), Novice, Beginner, Intermediate, Advance, (30 sec)

8 counts intro, 32 count square (8 counts of each side, executing a left flank on each count 8). Baton may be cradled or extended from arm with an arm swing. Free hand may be positioned on hip or left swinging at side.

MILITARY (foundation event), Novice*, Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced (30 sec)

Retraced L (left flank on first count 8, to the rear on second count 8, right flank on third count 8, half on fourth count 8)

PARADE MARCH INDIVIDUAL & LINES (non-sanction) Tiny Tot, Pri, Juv, Junior, Senior (30 sec)

You may choose to use the 8 count intro. Lines/individuals may not use gymnastics (cartwheels, walkovers, illusions, leaps-kicks Are Not acceptable) No formation changes, routine in a line form only; tosses & spins are accepted, keeping in mind aerial consistency in height and revolution will be judged. Judging will be based on posture, in step, leg height, toe point, unison, showmanship, and choreography. Lines consist of 2 or 3 members. Age groups are determined by average age.

PRESENTATION (foundation event) Nov*, Beg, Int, Adv (45 sec)

May start 12 count intro facing front or back. Simple baton/body combinations are appropriate. Traveling complex moves are not acceptable in the 12 count intro. The 12 count intro finishes facing the front.

SOLO – Novice*, Beginner, Intermediate, Advance (timing Beg/Int 1:29)

SOLO DUET & ARTISTIC PAIRS – Novice*, Beginner, Intermediate, Advance (timing Beg/Int 1:29 Adv 1:44)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The contest listed in this brochure is official USTA sanctioned and all USTA rules, regulations, judges and music will be used.
2. No refunds will be given for any reason whatsoever. This also includes postponement due to severe weather conditions and compulsory categories entered out of sequence.
3. Neither the contest directors nor the contest facilities will be held responsible for accidents, injuries or loss or property.
4. Concessions will be served throughout the day. No outside food or drinks are permitted in the building. No smoking on school property.
5. Admission \$8.00 Children \$5.00, Children under the age of 5 and Senior Citizens are free. Participating athletes and USTA professional members in good standing will not pay admission fees.
6. Program will be emailed to coaches & athletes entered, 2 days prior to competition. Programs will be available,
7. Contestants compete at the age they will be on December 31st of the year of the contest. Anyone falsifying a birthday or 1st place will be disqualified from the contest and no refund will be given.
8. There is a Non-member contestant fee for individuals of \$5.00 if not USTA members. Individual, Group, or Organizational Memberships may be obtained through www.ustwirling.com
9. The set system will be used. Check program and note the set and lane for each event entered. If you feel there is an error, please contact the contest director. If the error was a result from incorrect information on an entry, the contestant will be withdrawn from the event and no refund will be given. Contestant's name will be announced. Athletes will be given a minimum of three sets (if possible) between performances.
10. USTA has as a main goal, the development and promotion of GOOD SPORSTMANSHIP. Unsportsmanlike conduct and/or behavior will not be tolerated.
11. Rule changes made by the USTA Board of Directors will automatically go into effect at the proper time and take priority over those stated.
12. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. Entry must be received by the deadline date.
13. If you are entering CAS for evaluations, you must enclose a copy of your CAS record card or book.
14. Group and Freestyle comments will be provided via email with the use of a Digital Voice Recorder.
15. Music for all groups must be on their own individual CD.
16. The process of establishing a team or corps age divisions by averaging the ages of the members. Add all the ages together, then divide by the number in the group. Each group will have the option of competing in an older division than the average age if there is a least one member whose age is within that higher age division. When the average age has a decimal digit, drop the decimal and use only the number as the average age. Age division 8 & under – Tiny Tot (all members 7 & under), 9.99 & under – Primary, 10-13.99 – Juvenile, 14-17.99 Junior, 18 & over Senior.
17. An athlete may be a member of more than one team, but each team cannot compete against each other. An athlete cannot compete against him or herself.
18. If a group has entered a contest and the day of the competition a member cannot perform for any reason, and it changes your category, that group will not be able to perform in a new category. But you may still perform for comments only.
19. A competitive first place win – when there is a win with more than one athlete in a given division.
20. NOVICE – A contestant who has won less than three (3) competitive first place awards in that event. When the third first place award is won, the contestant may no longer enter the Novice division in that event.
21. BEGINNER – A contestant who has won less than five (5) competitive first place awards in that event. When the fifth first place award is won, the contestant may no longer enter the Beginner division in that event.
22. INTERMEDIATE – A contestant who has won less than ten (10) competitive first place awards in that event. When the tenth first place award is won, the contestant may no longer enter the intermediate division in that event.
23. ADVANCED – A contestant who has won ten (10) or more competitive first place awards in a particular event.

RULES AND REGULATIONS (CONT.)

24. As novice, beginner, or intermediate you may move freely into a higher classification even though entered in their own class. Advanced, intermediate, and beginners may not enter lower classes. All wins count except when there are no other athletes/teams in a division. USTA recognizes ALL OTHER TWIRLING ASSOCIATIONS 1st place wins.
25. Any age category may be COMBINED if less than three (3) are entered in the event.
26. Critique Events - Comments will be given through digital recording via email. (non-competitive)
In the event of a discrepancy, the judge's master is final.
27. Awards may vary slightly at different contests. This is the discretion of the contest director.
Awards: Individual 1st Trophy, 2nd - 5th place Medal. Group Events 1st thru 3rd Trophy.
28. There will be a \$30.00 NSF charge for any returned checks.
29. You may evaluate no more than 2 levels of Compulsories or Movement Technique at any competition.
