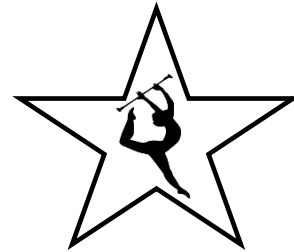

First Solo

For twirlers competing for first time with a solo.

Duets

Combined ages 0-18, 19-24, 25-30, 31+

0:30-2:00 min.

Best Costume

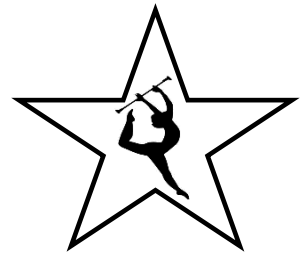
