**Directions:**

**From the North:** Take I -95 S. At exit 260B take ramp for I-4 West toward Orlando. At Exit 44, take ramp right and follow signs for SR-434 (.3mi) Turn Left onto SR-419 S/Sr-434 E (2.5 mi) Turn right onto SR 426/ W Broadway St (.8 mi). Turn right onto N Pine Ave (.1 mi) Arrive at N Pine Ave, High School is on the right.

**From the South:** Take I-95 N. At Exit 205 AB, take ramp for SR 528-Toll West toward Orlando. At exit 16, take ramp right for SR 417 Toll North toward Orlando/Sanford. Keep right to stay on SR 417 N/Central Florida Greenway. At exit 37A-B take ramp right for SR-417 N/Central Florida Greenway toward University BLVD. Take exit 41, follow signs for Red Bug Lake RD, bear right. Turn left onto SR-426 E/ W Broadway ST. Turn left onto N Pine Ave. Oviedo High School is on the right.

**From the East:** Take SR 528-Toll West toward Orlando. At exit 16, take ramp right for SR-417 Toll North toward Orlando/Sanford. At exit 37 A-B, take ramp right for SR 417 N Toll/Central Florida Greenway towards University Blvd. At exit 41, Take ramp right and follow signs for Red Bug Lake Rd. Bear right onto Red Bug Lake Road. Turn left onto W. Broadway Street, Turn left onto N Pine Ave. Arrive at north Pine Ave. School is on the right

**From the West:** Take i-4 east towards Orlando. Take exit 82A to SR 408 Toll east towards Titusville. At exit 18, take ramp right for SR 417 Toll North toward Sanford. At exit 37A-B take ramp right for Central Florida Greenway toward University Blvd. Take exit 41 and follow signs for Red Bug Lake Road. Turn Left onto w. Broadway Street. Turn left onto N Pine Ave. School is on the right.

## General Information

- ❖ **Entry deadline is Monday April 6, 2020** Entries must be postmarked by this date. A \$50 late fee will be added to all entries received after the deadline. No entries will be taken the morning of the contest. No refunds or credits will be given after deadline.
- ❖ You may submit your entry online, however you must print a copy and send it in with money order/cashiers check or pay with Paypal online. Please print an extra copy for yourself.
- ❖ Age divisions for all individual events are: 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15 and 16-up.
- ❖ Special Beginner solo is offered for athletes that have never won a first place in solo.
- ❖ No flash photography, eating, drinking or smoking in the gym.
- ❖ Contest starts promptly at 8:30am on Saturday and 8:00am on Sunday. Doors open one hour before start time.
- ❖ Events will be held in both gyms. Schedule is at the discretion of the contest director.
- ❖ A facility fee will be added to the individual entry form to help cover facility costs. A facility fee for team members has been added to the team entry fees. Facility fee includes gym entry and program book.

### Class A- Open Contest

All events for the open contest will follow the order on the entry form as much as possible.

Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> place trophies 2-5 place awards 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> place awards for all novice events

### Miss Majorette of Florida Pageant

Advanced division only. Solo determines division. This pageant qualifies winners and royalty for the Miss Majorette of America Pageant at AYOP. Contestants will compete in Dress modeling with interview (20% of overall placements), X-Strut (40%) and Solo (40%). **Awards:** First place overall winner will receive a trophy, banner, tiara and flowers. 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> place will receive trophy. Awards will be given to winners of each event.

### Florida Beginner & Intermediate Pageant

This is a qualifying pageant for the beginner and intermediate pageant at AYOP. Solo determines division. Contestants compete in costume modeling with interview (20% of overall placement), X-Strut (40%) and Solo (40%). **Awards:** First place overall winner will receive trophy, banner, tiara, and flowers. 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> place will receive a trophy. Awards will be given to winners of each event.

### Miss Sunshine State Majorette

This event is open to all novice twirlers. This pageant does not qualify winner for any event at AYOP. Contestants will compete in Costume Modeling with no interview (20% of overall placement), Basic (40%), Solo (40%). **Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup> place overall winner will receive a special novice award, banner and tiara. 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> places will receive a special novice award.

### Miss Sunshine State Marching Queen

This event is open to all twirlers. If you are advanced in either Basic or Military you must enter the Advanced division. Contestants will compete in Costume Modeling (20% of overall placement), Basic (40%) and Military (40%). **Awards:** 1<sup>st</sup> place overall winner will receive a trophy and banner. 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> places will receive a trophy.

### Miss Sunshine State Queen of the Day

This event is open to all twirlers. Contestants will model a dress that is appropriate to their age group. There is no Interview with this event. Awards : 1<sup>st</sup> Banner and Trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> trophies.

### Sunshine State All Around

This event is open to all twirlers. Contestants compete in X-Strut, Solo & 2-Baton. Solo Determines division. All events are counted equally. Awards : 1<sup>st</sup> Banner and Trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> trophies.

### Show Twirl

Competitors will perform to their own music. Props and novelty batons are permitted. Time limit is 1:30-2:00. This event Will be held in the auxiliary gym on Saturday.

### Collegiate Twirl

Twirlers will perform to their own music. Collegiate routines may use multiple batons. If time permits, the Winner of the collegiate event will perform at the awards show. Awards 1<sup>st</sup>- 5th place awards.

**Awards Ceremony will be at the end of the competition.**

**All Miss Majorette/pageant contestants should be in costume.**

**Florida State Group Championships**

**Corps and Teams:** All NBTA corps and team events may be entered.

**Twirling Teams, Dance Twirl Teams and Half-time Show Teams:**

Average Age: 0-7.99 Juvenile, 8-11.99 Preteen, 12-14.99 Junior, 15+ Senior

**Twirling and Dance Twirl Teams:** 4-8 Small, 9-More Large (X-Large will be added if needed)

**Half-time Show Teams (Show Twirl, Pom, Dance):** 4-13 Regular, 14+ Large (Kindergarten/X-Large will be added if needed)

**Jr. and Sr. High and College School Teams:** Dance twirl and Show team (2-3min) All twirlers must attend the same school. Two or more members.

**Corps and Team Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> -3<sup>rd</sup> place trophies.**

**Florida Team/Corps Member of the Year:**

This event is open to all team and corps members competing in the Florida State Championships.

The event will follow similar rules as the annual competition at AYOP. Twirlers must perform a square of basic march followed by a 30 second demonstration of the equipment used in their team routine. A letter from the director is not needed. Examples: Baton, poms, flags, etc.

The event will be held during the Saturday competition. Winners in each age group will be introduced during corps awards on Sunday.

**ATTENTION DIRECTORS:** It is mandatory that a complete list of names and ages of all group members are sent with your entry. Beginner division will be offered in Twirl team and Dance twirl events only. There are no state titles awarded to beginner teams. It is an open division and NBTA rules apply. **The group entry fee includes gym fee for teams only. There will be no additional fee added or collected at the door on Sunday.**

**Beginner teams and auxiliary teams, such as poms and dancelines will be competing in the auxiliary gym if needed.** It is the goal to have all teams out as early as possible with special consideration given to those teams that must travel the furthest distances. Corps events will take place in gym and be first on the schedule. Please let the director know as early as possible if there is a special request. While not all requests can be accommodated, we will try our best to make sure all groups have an opportunity to compete for the State Championship and that everyone will have an enjoyable day.

**Corps Awards Ceremony will take place during the judge's lunch break in the gym.**

**Team awards will be announced in the gym throughout the day.**

**Please no changing tents on the competition floor. We encourage you to set them up out of the site of the judges.**

**No warming up or coaching on the floor of the main gym. Please be courteous to all competitors and share the space. Half of the auxiliary gym will be designated for warm and practice starting after 11 am.**

**We will be using the set system for all strutting. This will prevent any conflict with modeling and provide a safe strutting area for all contestants. All strutting will take place in the main gym.**
