COVID-19 Guidelines

Contest Organization

The competition will be divided into 3-4 separate groups, most likely by AGE groups. Tape will be set-up for the participants to wait behind their lane ONE person before they compete. One week prior to competition groupings and times will be posted on the BAND app. Friday, April 30th, each grouping's events and contestants will be posted on the BAND app. All Team Events will occur in the last grouping (late afternoon).

Spectators

Contestants are only allowed 1 parent/guardian. There will be painters tape marking off seating areas to comply with social distancing. Attendees will enter through the main doors and exit through the main doors following flow of traffic signs.

Masks

Masks worn over the nose and mouth are required for ALL attending. Athletes must wear masks while warming up. An athlete may remove their mask while on the competition floor competing, but then must immediately put their mask back on upon completion of his/her event.

Team/Corps members MUST wear masks while warming up and while competing as six feet will probably not be maintained during the competing routine.

Screening Procedures

All in attendance will have their temperature taken at the front door with a no-touch thermometer upon arrival to the competition. If any of your family members have a temperature over 100 degrees the entire family will be asked to leave. We will have volunteers assigned to constantly wipe down/disinfect surfaces throughout the day.

If a registered contestant or someone in the family comes in contact with COVID-19 and quarantining is necessary 14 days before the competition date, please contact the director so changes can be made.

Costumes/Locker Rooms

- o Arrive in costume, with hair and make-up done before entering the building.
- o 1 costume limit per contestant for the day.
- o Hair must be worn in one style the entire day.
- o Locker rooms will be closed for your use, with access to regular bathrooms.
- o No tents allowed.

Advance MM of Iowa Contestants:

- o All other guidelines above apply; in addition 1 dress for Miss Majorette modeling.
- o Locker room will be open only to change into and from dress, if you are competing in the MM of Iowa Competition.

Teams

- o Music for corps and teams MUST be submitted electronically to unitwirler1@gmail.com
- o Teams will be able to change costumes in locker rooms.
 - Locker rooms will be labeled by teams before team grouping.
- o MUST wear masks warming up and on floor when competing.

Award/Scoresheets

All events, except Miss Majorette and pageant, will be posted on the BAND App. All score sheets and awards will be bundled together for pick up at the end of each session. Each athlete will receive a labeled bag with all scoresheets and awards inside of it.

Waiver

All individual contestants and spectators are required to adhere to COVID-19 safety rules and submit a signed Covid-19 waiver with entry. Team directors should send waivers for team only members with team entry.
