Description of Events

Novice Basic Skills Pageant

Contestants compete in modeling (**no interview**) in costume 20%, basic strut 40%, and solo 40%. Solo determines ability level, and this event is only open to novice twirlers.

Beginner/Intermediate Pageant

Open only to AL, MS and TN residents. Solo status determines Beg. or Int. division. 20% modeling in costume w/ interview, 40% x-strut and 40% solo. First place winners in Beg. and Int. pageant advance to Nationals.

Miss Majorette of the South

Open only to AL, MS, and TN residents in the Advanced division. Solo status determines eligibility. 20% modeling in dress with interview, 40% strut, 40% solo. Top three Advanced winners in each age division will advance to Nationals.

Loveliest Majorette Model

Model in circle "T", in costume. No interview.

Basic Skills I

Wrist spins right & left figure 8's right & left, horizontal spins right & left, 2-hand spins with body pass, 2-hand spins with leg pass

Basic Skills II

All skills listed above plus right thumb flips, left hand back hand flips, little joes flips, vertical finger twirls

Rating Lane Note:

This is not a competitive lane. All NBTA rules apply. Must be entered in the corresponding pageant or open event for solo and strut. Other rating lane events have no requirements.

South Regional Twirling Competition – What to expect?

Our goal is to provide an opportunity for teams and individuals to compete in the safest environment possible. Things will most likely look and feel much different than previous competitions. Below is a summary of some of the changes that will take place and to help us all prepare for the Covid protocols that must be implemented in order to keep everyone safe. Please stay home if you have any symptoms of a cold/respiratory illness or have been exposed to someone who has Covid.

Masks

Masks must be worn over the nose and mouth at all times in the building. Athletes may remove their masks when warming up and/or competing in the gymnasium

Rotating Spectators

Only 1 parent/guardian per athlete is allowed as a spectator. In order to ensure there is space for spectators to see their athlete compete, spectators will be rotating in/out of the gym constantly throughout the day as follows:

- For Individuals/duet events: Spectators will only be allowed in the gym 5 sets prior to their athlete's event and must exit immediately after their athlete competes.
- For team events: Spectators will only be allowed in the gym 3 sets prior to their athlete's event and must exit immediately after their athlete competes

This means you need to plan to be mobile – you WILL NOT be able to “move in” to the bleachers for the entire day. When your athlete is not competing spectators will remain in their assigned area.

Coaches

Each athlete may list one coach on their entry. Coaches will have unrestricted access to the gym & warm-up area as needed for their athletes.

Social Distancing

Social distancing MUST be practiced throughout the building which includes bleachers, awards table and announcer's table.

Temperature Checks

Temperature checks will be taken at the door and access to the gym will be denied if temperatures are above 100°.

Limited Seating

The number of spectators will be limited to accommodate social distancing and maximize the safety for everyone. Only 1 parent/guardian per competing athlete allowed in the building. Non-competing siblings or friends will NOT be allowed in the building. NO EXCEPTIONS

Dressing Rooms – Costume Changes

Due to the limited number of dressing rooms and restroom capacity, athletes are encouraged to wear the same costume all day. Athletes and parent will be assigned an area to set up 1 chair and changing tent. Athletes will arrive with hair fixed and dressed in costume.

Modeling

There will be an interview for pageant modeling events. Costume modeling for Beg/Int divisions. Dress modeling for Adv. division.

Arrival Times

Teams and Individuals will receive arrival times closer to the competition dates. Athletes and parent will not be allowed in the building prior to given time

Awards

Results will be posted online throughout the event. Athletes will be given a time to pick up their scoresheets, awards. This applies to teams as well.

2021 South Regional Covid-19 Compliance AGREEMENT

In order to have a safe and successful contest, all participants and spectators MUST adhere to the rules set forth by the contest director. Please note that this is a NBTA sanctioned contest held at an Alabama public school, so all Alabama Covid Policies & Guidelines are in effect.

1. Temperatures will be taken at the door and access to the building will be denied if temperatures are above 100°. If you have any symptoms of a cold or respiratory illness or have been in contact with someone who has Covid-19, please do not come to the contest for the safety of others.
2. Masks must be worn over the *nose* and *mouth* at all times in the building. Athletes may remove their masks when warming up and/or competing in the *gymnasium*.
3. The number of spectators will be limited to accommodate social distancing and maximize safety for everyone. **Only 1 parent/guardian per competing athlete allowed in the building.** Non-competing siblings or friends will not be allowed in the building. NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. In order to ensure there is space for spectators (only 1 parent/guardian per athlete is allowed as a spectator) to see their athlete compete, spectators will be rotating in the gymnasium constantly throughout the day as follows.
 - a. For individual/duet events: Spectators will only be allowed in the gym 5 sets prior to their athlete competing in an event and must exit immediately after their athlete competes
 - b. For group events: Spectators will only be allowed in the gym 3 sets prior to their athlete competing in a group event and must exit immediately after their athlete competes.
5. Warm-up Area/Procedures:
 - a. For individual/duet events: Athletes will be allowed in the warm-up gym 10 sets prior to their event.
 - b. For group events: Teams will be allowed in the warm-up gym 5 sets prior to their event.
6. Absolutely no food or drink is allowed in the gym except for water for athletes.
7. Due to limited capacity in restrooms – Teams and individuals will be assigned areas to set up. Bringing your own chair and pop-up tent is encouraged. We ask that you limit chairs and tents to 1 per athlete. Spectators and athletes will remain in your assigned area until your permitted time to enter the warm-up gym or competition gymnasium.
8. Social distancing must be practiced throughout the building, including bleachers, awards table and announcer's table in the gymnasium.
9. Due to Covid-19, the CONTEST DIRECTOR reserves the right to make adjustments to the schedule as needed to meet safety requirements for the number of people in the facility.
10. Entry fees are non-refundable, except in the event the contest must be cancelled. If the contest is cancelled, entry fees will be refunded.
11. The Contest Director reserves the right to enforce all rules and remove anyone not following these rules.
