GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRY DEADLINE: All entries must be received by January 10, 2021 – all entries must be paid in full at this time. Once your entry is received & paid you will receive the Dropbox link to upload your videos. **VIDEO DEADLINE** is Midnight, January 18, 2021

VIDEO REQUIREMENTS: Routines can be recorded wherever is convenient for you. Outside, Inside, house, studio, gymnasium. Try to video on a flat surface and be aware of background noises. Videos must not be edited & need to be current. All videos must be labeled with athletes name, age, event & skill division. *Please note that all routines will be protected and only viewed by judges.

ATTIRE: All twirlers should be in competition attire.

MUSIC: You are welcome to play standard marching music or upbeat music for all solo events, Basic & Military Marching and X-Strut should have standard marching music. Showtwirls/Rhythmics/Downfield/Halftime & Team events should make sure that your music can be heard clearly in your video before sending it in.

RECREATIONAL SOLO:

This is for the recreational twirler – Routine will be judged based on what skills are demonstrated, this is a great introduction for recreational twirlers into the competition arena. Routine can be a combination of all the skills the twirler has learned. Costume is not required

MISS WINTERFEST 3 PART EVENT:

This is a 3-part competition Best Appearing Modeling in costume for all levels (no interview) Solo and X-Strut (Basic Marching for Novice)

TEAMS: We are offering Recreational, Beginner & Advanced levels.

Small teams 3-8members, Large teams 9+ members

Twirl Teams, Dance Twirl & Halftime Divisions

Time limit is 3:00 Max

AGE DIVISIONS

1. Kinder – average 0 – 5.999

2. Primary– average 6 – 8.999

3. Preteen – average 9 – 11.999

4. Junior – average 12 – 14.999

5. Senior – average 15 and over

6. College – average age 18 and over. All members of a College Half-Time Show team must be attending a college, university, or professional school and/or furthering their education with either full-time or part-time active enrollment.

*Recreational level is for classes of twirlers that are not usually competitive. This division would be for twirlers who possibly take a weekly class and are at the novice level in twirling. Costumes are not required.

JUDGES: Qualified judges will be used for all events; judges' decisions are final.

AWARDS: All events - awards are medals. Divisions with less than 10 – we will award 1st-3rd, divisions with more than 10 we will awards 1st-5th. Participation ribbons for all other placements. Teams will be awarded a medal to each member for 1st-3rd place, participation ribbons for all other placements. Miss Winterfest – all entered will receive a placement award, winner will also receive sash. *Please note this competition is a non-sanctioned event, wins DO NOT count towards advancement.

SCORESHEETS: All events will be judged on a standard scoresheet. Scoresheets will be sent to twirlers via email.

AWARDS PRESENTATION: On February 6, 2021 by noon EST a pre-recorded Awards Ceremony will be uploaded to YouTube & emailed out to all participants.
