1. Kansas Wesleyan, Shannon Meis, Shannon's Stars Twirling Club, NBTA, and their representatives will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. EVERY participant or their representative must sign the release form on the entry.
 2. 2022 NBTA rules will be in effect including 2min. time limit for Show Twirl and Collegiate Solo.
 3. Contestants will perform in reverse order as the entries were received.
 4. NO flash photography. Video ONLY your own child, student or group as per NBTA rules.
 5. Concessions will not be offered. You may bring water or sports drinks into the facility.
 6. No admission fee at the door.
 7. VENMO payment only @StarsBoosters-BC or shannonsstarstwirling@gmail.com. Send as Family/Friend. No refunds unless we have to cancel. *Keep track of your entry cost as the form does not add it for you.
 8. Contest age is determined by the twirler's age on 9/1/21
 9. NBTA Judges' are final. Any conflicts will be resolved by the Head Judge.
 10. Contestants will follow the program - 1 provided with each entry.
 11. Awards will be presented for the top 3 places unless group size justifies top 5.
 12. Ratings/Divisionals - You will perform for a judge's critique and placement ribbon rather than competing against others. NBTA rule - you must enter the event in the regular contest in order to perform ratings.
