Pageant Rules: This is the official Miss Majorette of America preliminary competition for Tennessee to select representatives to the Miss Majorette of America competition. Solo determines your Miss Majorette division. (Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced). Beginner and Intermediate contestants title is now "TN Pageant Winner". All winners will be chosen by a point system based on placement in twirl, strut, and modeling.

Modeling Attire: Beginner & Intermediate Pageant

Divisions model in twirling costume. **Advanced** Miss Majorette 0-6, & 7-9 model short party dress. 10-12 model party dress or tea length or long dress. 13-15, 16 & over, & College divisions model either tea length or long gown.

THE FOLLOWING **GYMNASTIC STUNTS ARE DISALLOWED FROM ALL NBTA EVENTS**: body aerials, walkovers, cartwheels, butterflies, somersaults on the floor & body mounts & body tosses. (Refer to NBTA rules to see what constitutes a body mount.) Contestant/team will be disqualified from the event.

Schedule of Events: Doors Open at 7:30. Contest Begins at 8:30 with the Miss Majorette Modeling followed by other modeling events. 10:00 (Approximate time) Team Events, followed by strutting, twirling, novelty and show twirl events. ****Note:** Team Events will be held after modeling events

Smoky Mountain Majorette Princess Pageant (Open to both in and out of state contestants). Modeling is done in baton costume. Novice, Beginner & Intermediate: modeling (no interview), basic marching in a square, & solo twirling. Advanced: modeling (no interview), X strut routine, & solo twirling.

Show Twirl (Individual Dance Twirl) Time Limit: 1:30-2:00. Props and twirling equipment are limited to what can be hand carried in one trip by the contestant only. Individual selects their own music.

Rhythmic Twirl: Advanced only. One baton only (no props). Time Limit: 2:00-2:30.

1st Time Twirl: The contestants first time entering a "twirling/solo" routine in competition.

Novice: A contestant may remain in Novice division until they receive five 1st place wins in a category no matter the twirling organization. A 1st place win in a higher category results in an automatic advancement to the Beginner division.

****All Novice 1st place winners receive a medal instead of a trophy. (As per NBTA rules).**

TEAMS: Divisions & categories both State & Open Teams.

Divisions: Tiny Tots, Juvenile, Junior, Senior and College.

Categories: Dance-Twirl Team, Pom-Pom Team, Half Time Show Team, Dance Line Team, & Half Time Show/School Team.

Instructor must send in team entries & fees on Team Entry Form. \$10.00 Per Team Member
