Take 71 South to OH 95 W toward Fredericktown

Turn left onto Rte 42 (Russell Rd). Turn R on E Williams St (Rte 529)

Turn left onto OH 4 S Turn R on Somerlot-Hoffman Rd W

Turn R on OH 203 N, then at deadend, turn R to stay on OH 203

Turn L on Larue-Prospect Rd W; Turn R onto Keener Rd S. School on R

From Columbus and South:

Take Rte 33 W towards Marysville; In Marysville, take Rte 4 N toward Marion

Turn L on OH 203 N, then follow directions above

From Toledo, Michigan, and Northwest:

Take 75 south to OH 15 E

Take 15 E then continue on US 23 S around Upper Sandusky

Turn R on T-62 then turn L on Co Hwy 119 (Cherokee St)

Continue on 119 and Prospect-Upper Sandusky Rd

Turn R on Keener St W – School is on L

From Ft Wayne, Chicago and West:

Take US 30 E to Cty Hwy 78

Turn R on Cty Hwy 215, then turn L on T-84

Turn L onto OH 53N, then bear R immediately onto OH 37 E

Follow OH 37 through several turns, then turn R onto Larue-Decliff Rd

Turn R onto Decliff Rd, then turn L on OH 95 E

Turn R onto Larue-Prospect Rd, then turn L onto Keener Rd. S

Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo– No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.
Level 2 (Novice) Solo– No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1½ to 2 min.
Level 3 (Beginner) Solo - No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.
Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo– No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min
Level 5 (Advanced) Solo – No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

Boys/Mens Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.
Feature Twirler Solo – Open to ANY twirler age 15+. Combo of 1 baton &
novelty; standard twirling music – time: 1½ to 2 ½; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.
Nov, Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time -
same as solo classification. Ohio Residents only.
Nov, Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors. Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time
limit – same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

Beg. Int. & Adv., Two-Baton - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: ½ to 2 minutes
Beg. & Adv. Three-Baton - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over; Time: ½ to 2 min.
