**HIGH POINT AWARD** to solo twirler with most points earned – Nov/Beg., Int. and Adv. Division determined by solo level. All individual events count 5 pts. for entering each event, plus points for awards: 5pts. for 1<sup>st</sup>, 4 pts. for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3 pts. for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2 pts. for 4<sup>th</sup>, 1 pt. for 5<sup>th</sup>. (Level 1 (Spec. Beginner) Solo and Spec. Beginner Basic not included.)  
40 pts Minimum (Forms available at registration table).

**GROUPS:** AGES: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9); Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15 +)

- All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-9 members); Large (10+ members)
- Dance Twirl Teams**– Use own music; No Props; 1 baton only, 1½-3 minutes
- Level 1 Dance Twirl** (same as above; twirls restricted to no more than a 1 turn)
- Twirl Teams** – march music; 1 ½ - 3 minutes
- Duet Strut & Strut Teams** – Use own music; 1 – 3 minutes
- Novelty/Show Teams** – must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – 1 ½ - 3 minutes
- Pom Teams** – Use own music; no props; mounts restricted, 1 ½ to 3 minutes
- Majorette Squads** (Jr Hi/Sr Hi/College) – Short Program/ Long Program
- Color Guard** – Junior and Senior; Short Program/ Long Program
- Production Groups:** 10 members minimum; 4-8 minutes
- Corps:** Floor, Street Parade and Mini – 10 baton twirling members minimum

## INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS

- Beg. Dress Model** – Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time Limit 1:30 Max.
- Int. & Adv. Dress Model** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time 1:30 Max.
- Beg. Costume Model** (Best Appearing) - Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time 1:30 Max
- Int. & Adv. Costume Model** (Best Appearing) – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Nov., Beg. Int. & Adv. Fancy Strut** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+  
(No specific pattern required – Time limit: 2 minutes maximum)
- Special Beg. Basic March** – Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+  
(Has not won TWO 1<sup>st</sup> places in Basic March)
- Beginner Basic March** – Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March in a square
- Advanced Basic March** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March in a square
- Beg. & Adv. Military March** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

*NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.*

Girls Solo (All levels) Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

- Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo** – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.
- Level 2 (Novice) Solo** – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1½ to 2 min.
- Level 3 (Beginner) Solo** – No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.
- Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo** – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min
- Level 5 (Advanced) Solo** - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.
- Boys/Mens Solo** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.

- Feature Twirler Solo** – Open to ANY twirler age 15+ Combination of 1 baton & novelty; standard march music – time: 2 to 2 ½ min.; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.
- Nov, Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification; Michigan residents only; open to Boys & Girls
- Nov, Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit same as solo classification. Out of state residents only, open to Boys & Girls
- Beg., Int., Adv. 2 Baton** Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time Limit 1½ to 2 minutes)
- Beg. & Adv. 3-Baton** Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit ½ - 2 minutes)
- Duet Twirl** – Ages: 0-8.5, 9-11.5, 12-14.5, 15+ (averaged ages)  
Use standard twirling music - Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ minutes

- +Solo Dance Twirl** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ use own music; 1 baton only
- +Solo Show Routine** — **Beg. & Adv** - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+  
Use own music - any type of dance with baton AND novelty  
Beg. Time :30-2 minutes; Adv Time: 1½ to 2 ½ minutes
- +Duet Show Routine** – Same as Solo Show – Novelties optional; Use averaged ages
- +Solo Pom** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: 1½ minutes max – use own music
- +Duet Pom** – Same as Solo Pom – use averaged ages
- +Color Guard Solo or Rifle Solo** – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes
- +Color Guard Duet or Rifle Duet** – Same as Solo; Use Avg. Ages  
+ these events must be entered by SUNDAY, Mar 3 to be eligible to compete for awards

**Rating Festival** – performance for a rating only. Not a competition and all participants receive a ribbon. For special beginner (Level 1) twirlers ONLY
