FROM FOND DU LAC: US-41 S becomes US-45 S. Keep RIGHT to take US-45 S via EXIT 4 toward BELOIT. Take I-43 S toward BELOIT. Take the RACINE AVE / CR-Y exit- EXIT 54. Turn LEFT onto CR-Y S / S RACINE Ave.

FROM BELOIT: Merge onto I-43 toward MILWAUKEE. Take the RACINE AVE / CR-Y exit – EXIT 54. Turn RIGHT onto S RACINE AVE / CR-Y S.

FROM ILLINOIS: I-94 W / US-41 N toward MILWAUKEE. Take the WI-20 exit – EXIT 333 – toward RACINE / WATERFORD. Turn LEFT onto WASHINGTON AVE / WI-20 W. Turn RIGHT onto N RAYNOR AVE / US-45. Continue to follow US-45. Turn LEFT onto W LOOMIS RD / WI-36 S. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto MUSKEGO DAM DR. Turn RIGHT onto KELSEY DR. Turn RIGHT onto RACINE AVE / CR-Y.

ORDER OF EVENTS:

Subject to change based on contest size & time limitations!! ALL PAGEANT MODELING, followed by ALL OPEN CONTEST MODELING. Judges **may** break after ALL Modeling is completed. All other events to follow beginning with Basic Strut, Parade Majorette **AND** X-Struts. ALL OTHER EVENTS will follow in the normal fashion. Teams- at the end of the day.

WISCONSIN MISS MAJORETTE PAGEANT & OPEN MISS SUMMERTIME PAGEANT INFORMATION

- (A) Enter according to your current status in SOLO: Novice, Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced and College. If you are a Novice in Solo, you may enter the Beginner Pageant without having to remain in the Beginner division.
- (B) **IMPORTANT → ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF YOU FAIL TO COMPLETE SOLO STATUS SECTION.**
- (C) Ages: 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+ and College. Your contest age is according to how old you were on **September 1, 2024**.
- (D) Modeling Attire:
NOVICE SKILLS, BEGINNER, INTERMEDIATE: Must wear either twirling or strutting costume for modeling. Disqualification from the pageant for noncompliance with modeling dress code. May wear the same costume for all three parts.
ADVANCED: 0-6 & 7-9 - Short party dress; 10-12 - Party dress, long or tea length dress; 13-15, 16+ and College - Long or tea length gown.
- (E) There will be NO INTERVIEWS in the Novice Wisconsin or Novice Miss Summertime Pageants.
- (F) Pageant Order of Appearance: Contestants will model in alphabetical order according to last names beginning with the letter **"R"** for Modeling. Order will rotate by 1/3 each for Basic Strut/X-Strut and Solo events.
- (G) WISCONSIN PAGEANT AWARDS: 1st-5th in all divisions. First place awards in Modeling, Basic Strut/X-Strut and Solo in each division. Banner to Pageant First Place Winners in Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced.
- (H) OPEN MISS SUMMERTIME PAGEANT AWARDS: Novice: 1st-5th Ribbons; Beginner: 1st Trophy; 2nd-5th Medals; Intermediate: 1st-2nd Trophy, 3rd-5th Medals; Advanced: 1st-3rd Trophy; 4th-5th Medals. First place awards in Modeling, Basic Strut/X-Strut and Solo in each division.
- (I) **IMPORTANT: REVIEW YOUR SCORE SHEETS!** All results as posted/announced will be final within 48 hours following the contest date.

Beginner and Intermediate Wisconsin winners become eligible to enter the Beginner and Intermediate Pageants at AYOP.

Advanced Miss Majorette winners and Miss Majorette Royalty (1st & 2nd Runner-up) in each Advanced Wisconsin age division, become eligible to enter the Miss Majorette of America Pageant at AYOP. Under no circumstances will eligibility for Miss Majorette of America Pageants be passed on beyond third place (2nd Runner-up).

COSTUME MODELING: No interview. Special Novice, Novice, Beginner or Advanced

**BASIC STRUT:** Special Novice (never won a first in any Basic Strut event), Novice, Beginner & Advanced

**X-STRUT:** Special Novice (never won a first in any X-Strut event); Novice, Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced

**SOLOS:** First Contest (never entered any contest before), Special Novice (never won a first in any Solo event); Novice, Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced.

**INSTATE (Wisconsin Residents ONLY):** Special Novice, Novice, Beginner, Intermediate or Advanced.

**VISITORS SOLO (Residents outside WI):** Special Novice, Novice, Beginner, Intermediate or Advanced.

**BOYS' SOLO AND COLLEGE MAJORETTE SOLO:** Divisions and awards as entries warrant.

**NOVELTIES:** MILITARY MARCH, FLAG, TWO BATON & HOOP in Novice, Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced | THREE BATON (1 division)

**PARADE MAJORETTE SOLO:** Strut & Twirl in a square with continuous forward motion; Novice, Beginner, Intermediate or Advanced; Divisions as entries warrant.

**RECREATION DEPARTMENT SOLO EVENTS:** Solo & Basic March (in a square); Age divisions as entries warrant; 1st-5th ribbon

**AGE DIVISIONS AND AWARDS FOR THE OPEN CONTEST:**
