☑ AAU RULES: The current AAU Baton Twirling Handbook is available at www.aaubaton.org All current AAU rules apply.
□ <b>ALL EVENTS:</b> All athletes (solo and team) MUST be AAU members and must be able to provide AAU Membership numbers when submitting entry forms. AAU membership MUST BE OBTAINED prior to submitting entry ( <b>NOTE AGES 18+:</b> Membership is not instant so please allow several days to process).
□ <b>DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES</b> : All entries must be postmarked by March 1, 2026:(Phone/email entries are not accepted)

□ <b>ADVANCEMENT:</b> If you should win prior to this contest and need to advance, you must call or email ASAP so we can make the needed changes. All changes should be submitted by March 22, 2026
□ DOOR ADMISSION AND PROCESSING FEES: Spectator fee will be collected with entry.
<b>PAYMENT:</b> Make checks payable to: Twirling Bears All fees due with entries by March 1, 2026. \$30 Returned Check Fee. No refunds on entry fees or credits to other competitions will be given.
□ <b>DUET/TRIO/TEAM ROSTERS:</b> All directors must submit one roster for each duet/trio/team routine entered. Rosters should also be provided at "on-deck" check in for each routine the day of the competition.
□ <b>CHANGES TO ENTRIES:</b> The contest director reserves the right to make any changes necessary. No changes by contestants may be made once entry is received. ONLY errors made by the contest director will be corrected before the day of the contest. <b>NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE CONTEST.</b>
PROGRAM BOOKS: Programs will be available as part of admission at the check-in/awards table, emailed or posted. All solo participants will need a program in order to know lane assignments.
□ <b>PRACTICE AREA:</b> Athletes may not practice in front of the judges or in any area where there is risk of the baton rolling onto the floor and interrupting the routine of another athlete. Practice area will be available in the gym. Both sides of the gym are available for practice during breaks.
□ <b>MUSIC:</b> All team and solo events that require music (other than standard march music) must bring copies of your music on CD, or electronically to the the competition. A representative from the group must be present to play it.
□ SET SYSTEM: A set system will be used for this contest.
□ <b>FOOD:</b> A professional concession stand will be provided. No outside food or drink is allowed in the facility.
□ PHOTOGRAPHY: No flash photography permitted. Failure to comply can result in disqualification.
□ VIDEO TAPING: Video recording is only allowed by parent videotaping their own child or director/appointed person videotaping their own team/student. Failure to comply can result in disqualification.
□ LANES: Contestants are responsible for reporting to their lanes on time. Failure to do so can result in disqualification. □ WAIVERS: A waiver must be signed and returned with entry for every participant in the competition (solo and team members). Participants will not be allowed to participate unless a form has been properly filled out and signed by parent/legal guardian/self.

□ AAU POM TEAM: Poms must be used throughout routine. Poms can be grounded for no more than 3 counts of 8. Gymnastic skills MAY NOT be done with poms in hands.
CONTEST AGE: AGE AS OF 7-24-26
<b>TEAM AGES:</b> 0-6 (Tot); 7-9 (Juvenile); 10-13 (Junior); 14-18 (Senior); 19-22 (College); 23+ (Adult)
TIME LIMITS: 1:30-3 minutes
<b>TEAM SIZES:</b> Extra-Small (2-3 Members); Small (4-9 Members); Large (10-19 Members); Extra-Large (20+ members)
<b>TEAM STATUS:</b> Beginner (Team has 11 or fewer first place wins) or Advanced (Team has 12 or more first place wins)
<b>GYMNASTICS:</b> Beginner level limited to 1 Gymnastic/Tumbling skill per routine (one move total by one individual; not entire team). Advanced level limited to 3 Gymnastic/Tumbling Skills per routine (3 moves total by individuals; not entire team)
ACCEPTABLE GYMNASTIC MOVES INCLUDE: Cartwheels, Round-Offs, Front/Back Walkovers, Forward/Backward Rolls, Backhand springs.
NO OTHER GYNMASTICS MOVES WILL BE ALLOWED.
DANCE GYMNASTIC RULES:
GYMNASTIC MOVES ARE ALLOWED, BUT NOT REQUIRED
☐ The hands of the performer must be in full contact with the floor at all times without obstruction by costume or equipment
□ No Gymnastic/Tumbling Skills maybe done on top of equipment/prop
□ No Gymnastic/Tumbling Skills maybe used as a dismount from any equipment/prop
