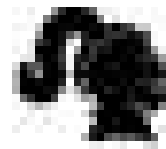

**General Information:**

- All contestants must wear tennis shoes or other non-marking soled shoes on the gym floor
- Food and beverages will be provided by the Silver Knights Parent Organization throughout the day, including multiple lunch options (walking tacos, hot dogs, pulled pork sandwiches, and more).
- Contest directors, staff, and Herget Middle School are not responsible for lost/stolen/damaged property, accidents, illnesses, or injury during the competition
- There will be ample practice space available. There will also be room for setting up "pop-up" tents for changing
  
- Entries must be submitted via online entry only. No fax, email, phone or snail mail entries accepted.

- Payment must be submitted at the time of the entry via Venmo (be sure to include contestant's name, phone number, and Midwest Regionals in the "What's for" section. Please do not send Venmo using purchase protection; if you do use that option, please include the extra amount to cover the protection feeds. If paying by check then the check must be received within 5 days. Entries will not be processed until payment is received.
- Contestant fee of \$30 must be paid by all contestants (waived for siblings after the first contestant fee paid)
- Any advancements in level must be reported within 24 hours of advancement**
- No late entries allowed for X-struts or pageants due to the use of a set system for those events
  - Late entry fee of \$5 per event must be included in any entries submitted after 6/1/26
- No changes will be made the day of the competition
- No refunds/credits
  
- Age divisions: 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+ (age as of 9/1/25)
- Order of events:
  - Saturday→modeling, basic strut, x-strut, down the field, show twirls, college & high school solos with own music, rhythmic twirl, solos, 2 & 3 baton, duets & trios
  - Sunday→Regional awards ( could be moved to Sat evening pending entries), teams & corps
- Awards for 1st- 3rd place for all open events and 1st-5th place for regional events. Additional awards added as division sizes warrant.
  - Open award winners have the option of choosing an award or saving up points to redeem for rhinestone TWIRLER pins or gift cards (Amazon, Bath & Body Works, Starbucks, Target, Ulta). Points may be carried over from contest to contest if desired to "save up" for a desired prize)

### **MIDWEST REGIONAL EVENTS (must reside or attend college in IL, IN, or MO): Divisions are 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+ (except Duets & Trios)**

#### **\*\*\*Double judging for Regional Adv model, X-strut & solo**

- Midwest Regional Pageant: Nov, Beg, Int
  - Nov→no interview with modeling portion
  - Beg & Int→modeling with an interview
  - Beg & Int winners will qualify for the national pageant at AYOP 2026.
  - Model in costume\*\*\*
    - \*\*\*Dress code→model costume must be the same costume as worn during either the strutting or solo portion of the same pageant. Contestant becomes ineligible for non-compliance with dress code per NBTA rules if above not followed.
- Miss Majorette of the Midwest Pageant: Adv
  - Modeling in dress with an interview
  - Class AA preliminary for Miss Majorette of America & Royalty Court
- Regional Modeling Championship: Nov (in costume, no interview), Beg (in costume, with an interview), Adv (double judged, in costume or DRESS, with an interview)
- Regional Basic Strut: Nov, Beg, Adv
- Regional Super X-Strut Championships: Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (Adv is double judged)
- Boys Regional Super X-Strut Championships: Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (Adv is double judged)
- Regional Solo Championships: Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (Adv double judged)
  - Adv Regional Solo will qualify 8 contestants for the 2026 National Majorette Championship solo at AYOP)
- Regional Boys Solo Championships: Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (Adv double judged)
- Regional College Solo Championship (double judged)
- Regional 2-Baton Championship: Nov, Beg, Int, Adv
- Regional 3-Baton Championship: Beg, Adv
- Regional Duet Championship: Beg, Int, Adv (0-18, 19-24, 25-30, 31+)
- Regional Trio Championships: 0-10.9, 11-13.9, 14+ (average age)
- Regional Show Twirl, Regional Pom Solo→must provide music in mp3 format with entry
- Regional Rhythmic Twirl (qualifies for rhythmic twirl at AYOP 2026)-->must provide music in mp3 format with entry

AWARDS: 5 awards for each event

#### **OPEN EVENTS:**

##### **Divisions are 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+ (except Duets & Trios)**

- Miss Chicagoland Pageant: Nov, Beg, Int, Adv, College
  - Nov model in costume, no interview
  - Beg & Int model in costume, with an interview
  - Adv model in DRESS with an interview
- Modeling→Pri, Nov, Beg, Adv (modeling in costume, no interview); must enter at least 1 other non-modeling event
- Dress modeling→one level, with an interview
- Open Basic Strut→Pri, Nov, Beg, Adv
- Open Super X-Strut→Pri, Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (same levels also available for boys)
- Open Solo, Instate Solo, Visitors Solo→Pri, Nov, Beg, Int, Adv (same levels also available for boys)
- Open College Solo
- Recorded Feedback Rating Lane→Modeling, X-Strut & Solo
  - You will hand the judge/clerk your phone and they will make live comments while your routine is recorded on your phone so that you can review your commentary at any time. Judge will also provide verbal feedback upon completion of your routine
  - Must also enter your own level of same open event
- Chicagoland Down the Field→Junior High, High School, or College
